

Silver androsace

Androsace argentea

The silver androsace is a dwarf plant that forms compact cushions. The leaves are closely intertwined in a columnar pattern and are covered with hairs that give the cushions their characteristic silvery-grey appearance. The flowers are white but turn red as they dry.

Not to confuse

The star-shaped hairs of the silver androsace prevent confusion with other androsaces.
